EXXONMOBIL RETIREE CLUB OF JOLIET 2018 DEEDS PROGRAM

Retiree Affairs developed the DEEDS Program to promote and recognize community volunteerism by annuitants, their spouses, and surviving spouses. Retiree Affairs develops and distributes DEEDS recognition for all volunteer participants who report their accomplishments on the annual DEEDS report form. The Club will combine the responses we receive into a summary report filed by the ExxonMobil Retiree Club of Joliet for DEEDS performed in 2017 and present the awards in 2018 at a ExxonMobil Retiree club meeting.

The PURPOSE of the DEEDS Program is to:

- Encourage retirees, their spouses, and surviving spouses to channel their energies into charitable community activities.
- Encourage ExxonMobil retiree clubs to participate as a group in various community charitable activities.
- Enhance the positive public image of the ExxonMobil retiree groups in their communities
- Provide a positive community service activity to increase the public visibility of ExxonMobil Retiree Clubs.

Retiree Affairs will provide an annual recognition memento for each person who meets the eligibility requirements.

ELIGIBILITY: All ExxonMobil retirees, their spouses, and surviving spouses who perform 50 or more hours per year of volunteer work for charitable, social welfare, health, civic, scientific, medical, literary, educational or cultural organizations. The eligible organizations include such groups as local fire departments, ambulance and first aid groups. Service provided to religious or political groups is excluded from eligibility in the program. However, a church program which provides charitable services for the community beyond its membership (for example meals on wheels) is eligible and should be recognized by DEEDS.

Please provide on the form below, the total number of hours during 2017 that you, your spouse, or surviving spouse have performed volunteer service for qualifying organizations along with a listing of the included organizations. If the total volunteer hours meet or exceed 50 hours, your efforts will be included on the club report to Retiree Affairs and will be recognized with a Retiree Affairs recognition memento.
