The club held its annual dinner/election meeting on December 8th 2022, at the St. George Serbian Center. There were two orders of business on the agenda, the first was the election of three board member positions. Nick Hively, Mark Fredrickson, and Jeannie Myers 2-year terms were expiring. Nick Hively, Mark Fredrickson, and Eugene Satrun agreed to run for the three positions. Jeannie Myers agreed to move to the Program Committee rather than rerun for the board. We would like to thank her for her service to the board and look forward to her work planning club events.

The board met on January 11, 2023 to elect officers for the new year. The officers for 2023 remained the same with the exception being Wayne Dailey moving to the Membership Chair replacing Jeannie Myers and new board member Eugene Satrun going to the Nominating Committee replacing Wayne Dailey.

The second order of business was the adoption of revised Club Bylaws. The board voted to increase the yearly fee for Associated Member from \$35/year to \$40/year. This is because ExxonMobil increased their member subsidy from \$25 to \$30 per retiree. XOM only provides this subsidy to employees that retire with full benefits. Associated Members are those that retire from XOM without full benefits. This Associated Member fee was specifically listed as \$35/year. The Club Bylaws were modified to read that the Associated Member fee will be the current Member Fee plus the current XOM subsidy payment. This way, if the XOM subsidy payment increases in the future, the board can increase the fee without amending the Club Bylaws.
